- 1. What is the purpose of the motion to reconsider? (39)**
 - A. The purpose of the motion to reconsider is to permit the reconsidering of a vote previously taken on a motion and to again reconsider the question. (29)
- 2. May a division be reconsidered? (37)**
 - A. A division cannot be reconsidered. (3 & 23)
- 3. Is the motion to reconsider debatable? Amendable? (39)**
 - A. The motion to reconsider is debatable if the question to be reconsidered is debatable. The motion to reconsider is unamendable. (3 & 29)
- 4. What is the purpose of the motion to rescind? (39)**
 - A. The purpose of the motion to rescind is to cancel action taken by the chapter. (30)
- 5. Does a point of order require a second? A vote? (37)**
 - A. A point of order does not require a second. A point of order does not require a vote, unless it is referred to the chapter for a decision. (3 & 19)
- 6. When may an amendment be offered to a motion? (37)**
 - A. A member may offer an amendment to an amendable motion after the chair states the question and the member obtains the floor. (9, 16, 17, & 18)
- 7. Is the motion to refer debatable? Amendable? (37)**
 - A. The motion to refer is debatable and amendable. (3 & 15)
- 8. Does a nomination require a second? What vote is required to elect? (38)**
 - A. A nomination does not require a second. A majority vote is required to elect. (3 & 23)
- 9. How may nominations be made? (38)**
 - A. Nominations may be made by a committee or from the floor by a member. Even when a nominating committee is used, nominations may be made by members when the floor is open for further nominations. (23)
- 10. After a committee report has been given, should a copy of the report be filed? If yes, with whom? (39)**
 - A. Yes. A copy of each committee report should be filed with the secretary. (32)
