

## CP FFA Prospect Show Rules and General Information for 2020:

No early entries will be taken this year. Only one entry per animal. Show open to all counties. Students must be enrolled in 4-H or FFA programs, unless they are a pee-wee showman. **Showmanship** is \$5 each time in the ring and will be paid at the gate.. Pee-wee showmanship is free.

Three rings will be provided: one for swine, one for lambs/goats, and one for cattle.

Showmanship is divided as follows:

1-7 years old- Pee-wee

8-13 years old- JR

14-19 years old- SR

20+ Adults

Each class will be broken down as evenly as possible. NO weigh-backs. Show rings will not wait for an entry who is exhibiting in another ring, but substitutes may be used.**FOR BREEDING STOCK:** Please see the notes per species. **LAMBS-** ewes show as market lambs. **MARKET GOATS-** wethers only. **SWINE-** gilts show in ring with barrows. **HEIFERS-** There will be a separate division/show for Commercial Heifers. Commercials will not compete in overall or against registered heifers, but will receive an award for their show. Please bring any papers to show ownership and preferably breed. No shavings allowed, dirt is provided. No clippers or generators in the barn. ALL judges decisions are final.

The following lists the breakdown of the show: **LAMBS:** Division I- Fine wool and Fine wool-cross, Division II- Medium/heavy wool. **GOATS:** Division I- Light Weight, Division II Medium Weight, and Division III- Heavy Weights. **SWINE:** By breed. Duroc, Hampshire, OPB, Cross. **CATTLE:** American Division, British Division, Exotic Division, and commercial heifer show.
